

How to get there

The 529 bus leaves Bodmin town hourly for St Austell, where you change for the 25 First service to Fowey

Things to do

Visit the Du Maurier Centre and learn about Daphne Du Maurier and her writings. See her home, Ferryside, across the river, at Bodinnick

Catch the passenger ferry across to Polruan and walk the Hall Walk up the estuary to Boddinnick and then back via the Boddinnick car ferry

Visit the aquarium

Stroll along the Esplanade to Readymoney cove, a small sandy beach perfect for families with small children

Hire a boat from the harbour and take a leisurely ride up the river

Take an organised boat trip up to Lerryn and Lostwithiel (Tide permitting) and have a few hours wandering around the antique shops in Lostwithiel

Learn about the history of Fowey on one of the Town walks or Town tours by land train (bookable at the Tourist Information Centre ☎ 01726 833616)

Take a walk west along the coast path from St Catherine's point out towards Polridmouth or on further to the sailor's daymark at Gribbon Head

Wander around the stylish shops and galleries

Try your hand at fishing or crabbing off the harbour wall

Paddle a hired canoe up river (☎ 01726 833627)

Visit the small museum

Enjoy a drink on the harbourside and watch the sailing boats gliding up and down the river
