

## **How to get there**

The 555 bus leaves Bodmin town hourly for Bodmin Parkway station, where you catch the train to Penzance

## **Things to do**

Stroll around the harbour and watch the sailing boats or the Scillonian returning from the Isles of Scilly

Visit the award-winning Penlee gallery and Museum for an insight into the pre history of the area and evolution of social life and culture in Cornwall. The Gallery focuses on the Newlyn school of artists

Walk east along the coast path to Marazion for a visit to St Michael's Mount

Walk west along the coast path to Newlyn to watch fish being landed and visit the Pilchard museum. Stroll around the Newlyn Art gallery If you plan to visit over the August bank holiday you can visit the Newlyn Fish Festival

Take a relaxing break in Morrab gardens, situated in the centre of the town with 3 acres of numerous sub tropical plants and free entry.

Take a short bus trip to Mousehole (no 5 or 6) one of Cornwall's prettiest coastal villages, 3 miles from Penzance

Visit in June for a chance to join in the Golowan festival, incorporating Mazey Day

Observe the statue of Sir Humphry Davey outside the market house, holding the miners safety lamp that he invented

Visit the Trinity House National Lighthouse Centre, a stunning exhibition of maritime safety. Opened in 1991 by the Duke of York, the museum has one of the finest collections of lighthouse equipment in the world.
